Lessons learnt

- Update SOPs and emergency planning procedures

- Refine business continuity plans
- Maintain dashboards and concepts used (e.g. communication)
- Ensure that protection measures and hygiene are respected
- Anticipate and ensure minimal pharmacy stock needs by stocking “pandemic inventories” of drugs, disinfectants, and PPE
- Monitor and evaluate drug use, availability and shortages
- Exchange directly with stakeholders (wards, administration, etc.)
